

This year, Kidpower answered a critical call. As schools face challenges from mental health crises to safety concerns, our mission to empower children with practical safety skills has never been more vital.

We rose to meet the need. Kidpower reached 3,125 kids, teens, and adults across 99 programs, offered in schools, agencies, and at our location. We expanded into rural communities like Ellicott and Elbert, ensuring no geography limits a child's access to safety education. True to our promise, we turned no child away—with 73% of our programs fully paid for by generous grants and donor contributions.

Children are walking taller, parents are feeling more confident, and communities are growing stronger together. **Your partnership makes this possible**. You help us reach the children who need us most, especially those facing the greatest barriers.



WHAT WE ACCOMPLISHED



We raised awareness about child harm and how to mitigate it in the community.



We added 9 new schools and agencies, expanding access to Kidpower's safety programs for more children and families.



We trained a new Kidpower instructor, strengthening our team for the future.



We expanded services into rural communities, bringing Kidpower to new areas that had not previously had access to our programs.



We successfully trained more than 3,000 kids, teens, and adults, with a staff demonstrating resilience and committment.

IMPACT STORY



"My son, Ben, took a Kidpower workshop at his school recently. Today I got a call from the assistant principal at his school. She wanted to let us know that Ben reported an incident to her where another student touched his private parts in the lunch room today and it made him uncomfortable. She said the incident was addressed with consequences.

I don't think he would have reported it prior to Kidpower. I'm proud of him. He is only 6 years old and I wasn't sure how much he was picking up in class but, as you said, he did hear what the instructors were teaching. I am glad he recognized that it made him feel uncomfortable and was able to report it to a safe adult. Knowledge is power.

I think seeing the instructors and students role-play how to navigate those conversations is really powerful. It destigmatizes the topic and gives them a road map, should the need ever arise in their lives. Thank you."




